Terms and conditions for using Data Delivery Service (DDS) provided by SciLifeLab Data Centre

1. General

These conditions apply to the use of Data Delivery Service (DDS) supplied by SciLifeLab Data Centre. Further conditions from users' organisations or institutions may also apply. It is the user's responsibility to inform themselves of any additional conditions.

DDS is a service built for the standardised, simple and secure delivery of data from SciLifeLab platforms to their users.

2. User accounts

A user account is strictly personal and shall not be used by anyone else besides the user. That is to say, it is prohibited to provide account access to anyone else or to use anyone else's access information.

3. Passwords

All passwords shall be confidential and handled securely to prevent other parties from gaining access. It is the user's responsibility to manage their password securely.

If there is any suspicion that another party might have knowledge of a password, it should be reset immediately.

Keys, certificates and other means of authentication shall be handled as securely as passwords.

4. Connection

Connection shall only be made from a computer with a good level of security via secure connection; that is to say, a computer that is kept updated and that does not contain any viruses, trojans or other malicious software.

Connection shall not be made from a country subject to Swedish export restrictions for goods and technology, including software. It is the user's responsibility to inform themselves of these restrictions.

5. Usage

The service shall only be used for the purpose outlined above in section 1.

It is the user's responsibility to ensure that any data, code, or other information submitted to, or used in connection with, the service, is in compliance with any relevant data and/or legal requirements.

6. Consideration for the user community



This service might be shared by multiple users and, when using the service, consideration should be given to other users. Users are encouraged to share knowledge and best practice for use of this service.

As a user of our service and thereby a member of our platform, we encourage you to uphold the principles of respect, kindness, and inclusivity in all interactions within our community. By participating, you agree to:

8. Monitoring and consequences

SciLifeLab Data Centre retains the right to monitor and log all usage of, and access to, the services provided; the purpose of this being to ensure security, verify that regulations are observed and continuously improve the service.

The personal information that we collect is used for providing and improving the service. All collected personal information will be processed for research purposes, i.e. using the lawful basis of public interest and in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016, the General Data Protection Regulation.

Users and user accounts under investigation for rule violations can be temporarily suspended with immediate effect. Depending on the type of infringement and previous offences, measures taken against a user found to have broken the rules can amount to anything from a reprimand to a withdrawal of access to resources and services. Suspicion of breach of the law can lead to a report to



the suitable authorities. Other legal measures, such as bringing an action for damages, can also be taken.

SciLifeLab Data Centre may change the terms of this User Agreement at any time. Users will be notified of User Agreement changes. The continued use of the service will be considered as agreement to the updated terms.
